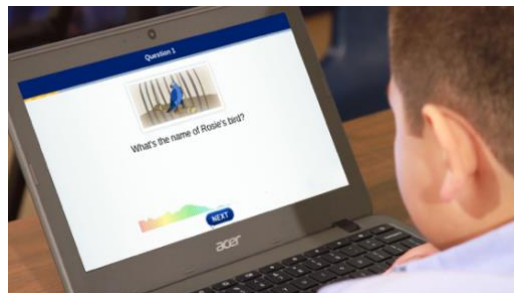


# ADMINISTERING MOBY.READ ON AN IPAD – QUICK REFERENCE FOR TEACHERS



**MOBY.READ**

*Assess oral reading fluency of K-5 students in 15 minutes. Students read aloud and retell stories, and then answer questions about the stories. Moby.Read is self-administered and automatically scored. Reading scores are immediately available on the iPad or online.*

## 1 Download Moby.Read

Download the Moby.Read iOS app from the App Store. (**Note:** Moby.Read Lite is the demo app).

## 2 Register

To administer a test, you need an AMI Teacher account. Registration for Moby.Read is by invitation. Follow the instructions in the email invite to complete the registration.

## 3 Create a class roster

1. Launch the Moby.Read app and sign in with your grade, then select **Class Roster**.
2. On the class roster page, tap **Add Students** and use the keypad to enter a student.

3. Provide a unique student ID, such as a school or district-assigned ID.

**Note:** Each student must be unique within your school or school district to allow student progress to be tracked across rosters within your school or school district. Contact your Moby.Read School

Administrator for instructions on obtaining or creating a unique student ID.

- (Optional) Specify a short alias that the student can remember, which is unique within the teacher's class.

4. Select the test form.

**Note:** Additional roster features, such as import and export of student data, are available online at [www.amiteacher.com](http://www.amiteacher.com).

## 4 Administer a test

Explain the test to students and show them a demo if possible (see 4.3 Demo the test). Administer the test in a quiet place. If you are using a headset (highly recommended), connect it to the device, and make sure it fits properly. Allow use of microphone when prompted (disable ad blockers if installed).

Tests may be administered in two ways:

1. With a token. Use this option if the test is taken remotely or in the classroom.
2. With a Student ID. Use this option only if the test is taken in the classroom.

### 4.1 Administer a test with token

To administer a test using a token, follow these instructions:

1. Launch the Moby.Read app and sign in with your grade, then select **Class Roster**.
2. Once all student IDs, names, and forms are populated, click **Generate Tokens**.

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**Note:** Forms must be selected on the roster prior to generating the token.

- On the token generator page, tap the checkbox for the student who you wish to generate tokens for. Tap the top checkbox to select all students.
- If needed, change the expiration date. To change expiration dates for all students at once, use the drop-down menu within the **Expiration** heading.

- Tap **Generate Tokens**.

**Note:** A token is valid for one-time use. It becomes invalid after the student completes the test or the expiration date is reached.

Changing the form or the expiration of an existing token will not automatically update the token information. Repeat steps 3-6 if changes are needed for an unused, existing token.

- To change the form or expiration date for an existing token, make the change on the roster or on the token generator page. Then click **Generate Tokens** again to save changes.
- Launch the Moby.Read app and tap Student with Token.

- Enter the student's token and tap Enter.
- Confirm the student's identity and tap YES.

The test begins and runs automatically. When the test is complete, Moby.Read returns to the ID input screen.

## 4.2 Administer a test with Student ID

- Launch Moby.Read and sign in as a Teacher. Select the grade you wish to administer.
- Enter the student ID or alias and tap **Enter**.

- Confirm the student's identity and tap **YES**.

The test begins and runs automatically. When the test is complete, Moby.Read returns to the ID input screen.

## 4.3 Demo the test (optional)

Show your students a demo ahead of the test to model the experience. Launch Moby.Read and tap **Guest Login**. Use ID 2-1001 for a full 2nd grade demo.

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## 5 Review scores

Test results are available for review immediately after completion of the test. On the iPad, tap **Back > Class Roster** or log in at [www.amiteacher.com](http://www.amiteacher.com) to review scores online.

## Score components and scales

- **Comprehension** (0-8) – measures the student's understanding of text materials based on story retells and short answers.
- **Accuracy** (0-100%) – the percentage of correctly read words out of the total number of words attempted by the student when reading a passage.
- **Rate** (0-250 WCPM) – the rate at which a student is reading words correctly, reported as words correct per minute (WCPM).
- **Expression** (0-4) – measures how well a student reads with emphasis, intonation, and timing.
- **Level** (mA-mZ) – captures the student's overall oral reading fluency ability. Levels consider the student's Accuracy, Rate, and Comprehension, and align with an alphabetic scale from mA (Moby.Read A) through mZ (Moby.Read Z).

**Note:** Kindergarten assessments do not score Rate and Expression.

## Level equivalence

Access the Fountas & Pinnell Equivalence Table on the roster page. The table maps Moby.Read levels to this commonly used reading scale.

## Review performance charts

Tap a score to see a chart plotting student performance over time. Tap a node to display the score and test date.



### Color-coded performance indicators

- Scores are at or above grade level
- Scores are slightly below grade level
- Scores are below grade level

## Listen to recordings

Tap a node in a student performance chart to listen to recordings of the student's responses.
